Tiwana Flagg-Martin was a dedicated educator who exemplified leadership and compassion in educating our youth. She was committed to the values of quality journalism, free expression, and community service which she served diligently.

This scholarship is awarded to a high school senior pursuing an education in a degreed program or technical career. This is a one-year, non-renewable scholarship in the amount of \$500.00. This scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student based on the following criteria:

- Active member of Emanuel Missionary Baptist Church, Inc. (Membership classifications: Baptism, Christian Experience or Restoration). Active members attend church regularly, support the church financially, and participate in church activities outside of regular service. For example, special projects, events, etc.
- Student may apply from public, private, vocational, technical, parochial, and alternative high schools throughout the United States.
- Graduating high school senior or a graduate from home school education.
- Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
- Demonstrate participation in community service activities completing seventy-five plus hours.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Plan to enroll in an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school by the fall term of the high school graduating year.
- Must be a U.S. resident.
- Applicants must write a 1,500 – 5,000-word essay describing a personal or private issue the applicant participates in that will be effective in his/her community. Include a cover sheet with your topic, name, address, and phone number.
- Submit a Resume. (Use the resume included in this packet)
  - Two references – one (1) from church leaders and one (1) from community on letterhead. Include the name, address, and telephone number of each reference.
  - List additional information that you want the scholarship committee to know.

## **Documentation**

- Evidence of completion of seventy-five plus community service hours. Please submit

**signed documentation of community service hours.**

- Proof of Graduation (copy of diploma) on or before June 2, 2024.
- A copy of letter/s of acceptance from a college, university or Vocational/Technical School must be submitted on or before May 26, 2024
- A graduation photograph must be submitted on May 26, 2024.
- Submit copies of documentations for honors and accomplishments.
- Submit an **abbreviated biography** to be published in the scholarship Souvenir Booklet.
